
ADDRESS TYPES






There are a few variations of address types in Policy Pro, including:


Mailing Address, Residence Address, and Risk Address.

This document will explain where each type is found, and what they mean.


MAILING ADDRESS

- The **Mailing Address** is where the Insured will receive mailed items from AFR. This can be found in various places such as New Quote, Customer Info, and the Basic Information screen.
- The Mailing Address may also be different than the Residence Address and the Risk Address.
 - (Example: A Landlord has a rental property and has Policy Docs sent to their house versus the house being leased out.)

RISK/RESIDENCE ADDRESS

- The **Risk Address** is the address of the location being quoted or insured under the policy. This can be found in various places such as New Quote, Customer Info, and the Basic Information screen.
- The **Residence Address** is the address where the named insured lives or resides. The Residence Address will often be the Risk Address, especially on a Homeowners policy, but may not be same on a Dwelling policy.
- The Residence Address and the Risk Address can both be different than the Mailing Address.
